Lake Kanasatka Watershed Plan Implementation

NH Department of Environmental Services (NHDES) and the Lake Kanasatka Watershed Association (LKWA) announce the release of a Request For Qualifications (RFQ) for Technical Services, Lake Kanasatka Watershed Plan Implementation. In January 2024, LKWA applied for a NHDES 319 Grant for funding to reduce or eliminate phosphorus loading and stormwater runoff on two adjacent sites on the eastern shore of the lake in an area known as Burton Road. The proposal was approved, and the project's Grant Agreement is currently pending State approval.

LKWA has prepared the RFQ in cooperation with NHDES to solicit submittals from qualified contractors who are interested in bidding on the project. The overall goal of this project is to significantly reduce the sources of phosphorus discharge and stormwater runoff into Lake Kanasatka from the Burton Road site.
