**Water Quality-** regular schedule of testing, cyanobacteria and invasive species watcher

Commission, other lake associations (Sunapee) etc.)

**Advocacy**- follow NH legislative bills related to lake issues and send out reminders via Facebook and newsletter. Follow Moultonborough meetings such as the Conservation Commission and/or the Selectboard and share pertinent lake related information via Facebook or newsletter
